Chris explained to Dan and Steve our parking situation. We have no assigned parking but use Red tags and Blue tags for resident usage of parking areas. Green tags for covered parking.

Dan then took over the explanation of the reason for our meeting. XXXXXXXXX has filed a housing discrimination complaint with the Office of Human Rights on August 8, 2022 against us.

Steve explained the legal requirements for a disabled parking request.

- The complainant must be determined disabled by receiving a placard from any state or federal agency.
   XXXXX has met the need to be affirmed by a State agency as legally disabled by getting a handicapped car license plate.
- 2. The complainant must produce verification from a medical professional regarding the disability as to why it is necessary to have assigned parking.
- 3. The Association must give reason why disabled parking is reasonable or undue to the complainant.

Dan then explained that on July 14, 2022, the XXXXXXXXX were sent a certified letter from the attorney representing the Association requesting the medical professional's assessment of his disability, and that the information had yet to be received.

In order to maintain neighborly accord, the Association authorized Ms. Titus, close friend, to approach XXXXXXXXXX with information regarding the requested disabled parking from a medical professional on or before August 26, 2022.

The Association is required to respond to the HUD complaint, filed, no later than August 31, 2022.
